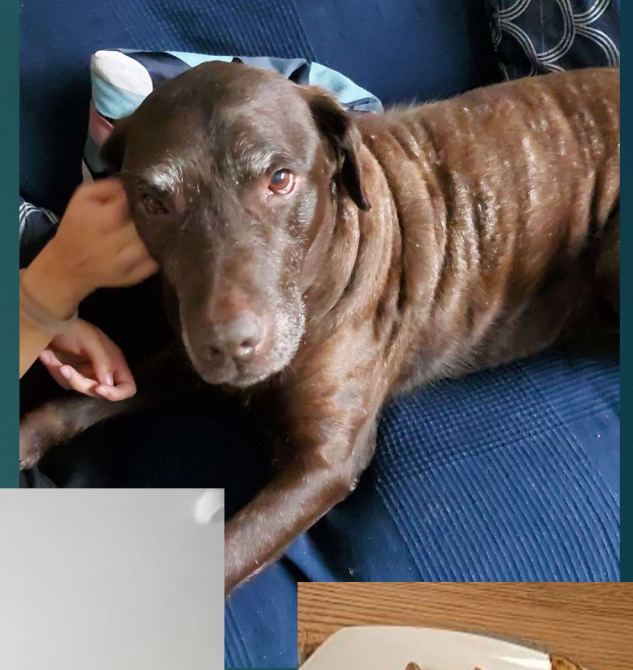

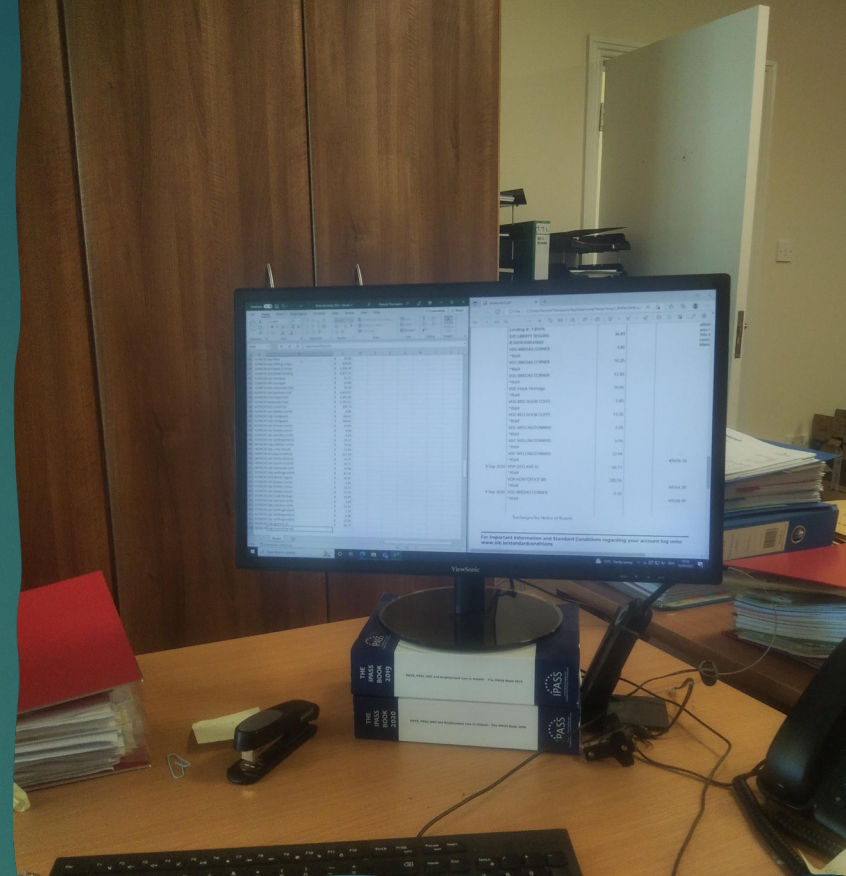

Aldus

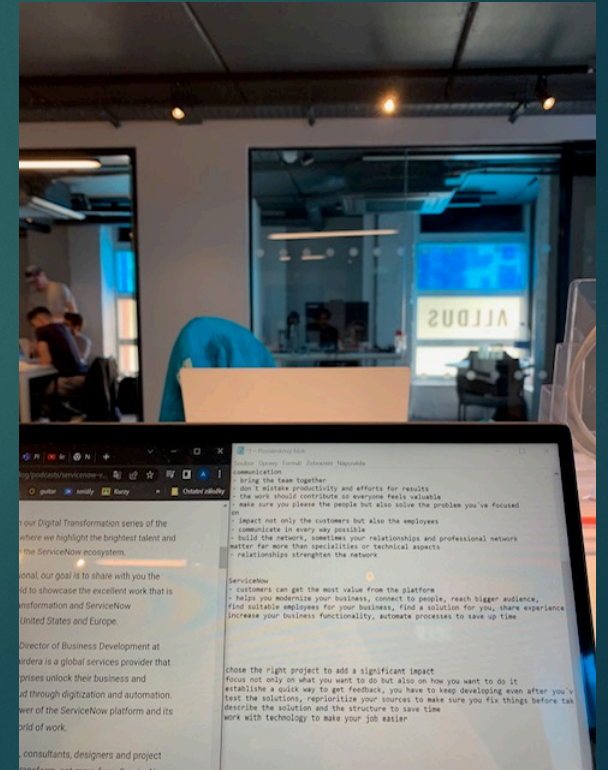
- ▶ I, together with Adéla, got to work for a company called Aldus.

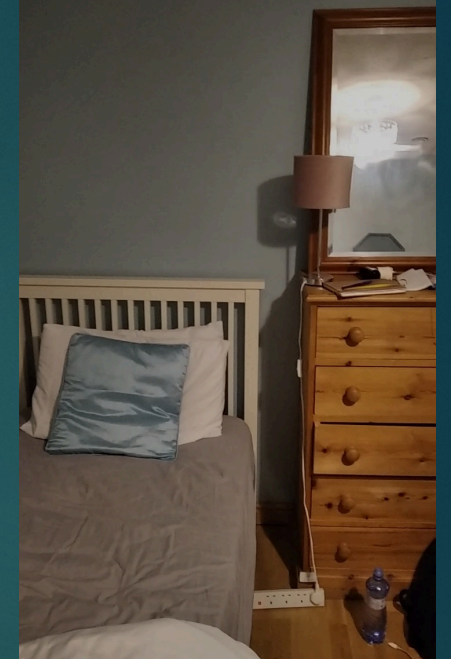

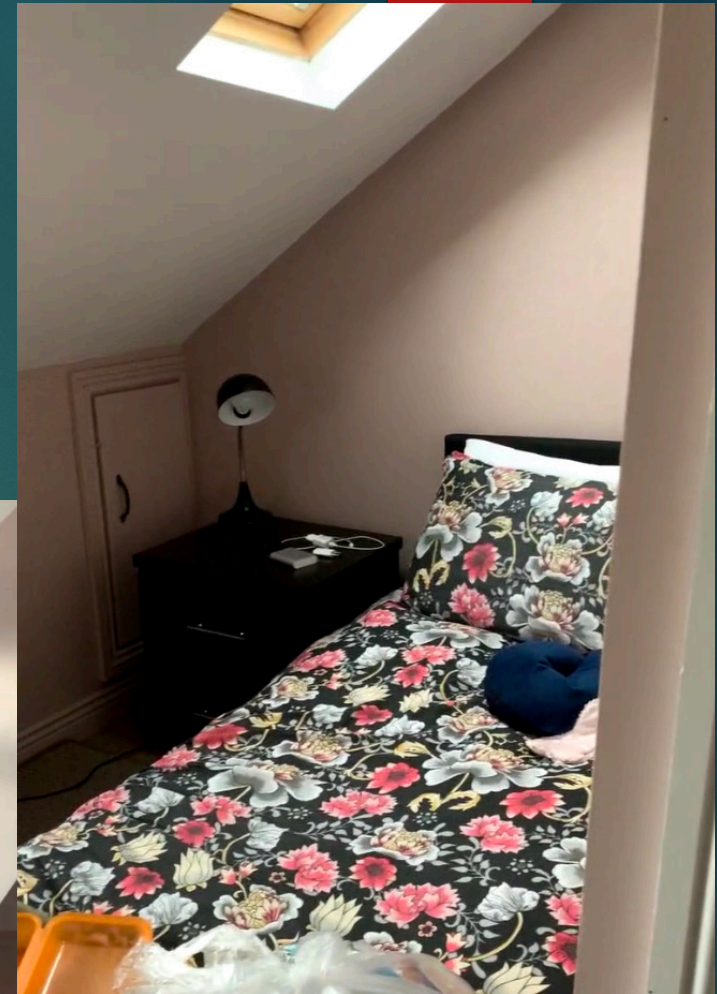

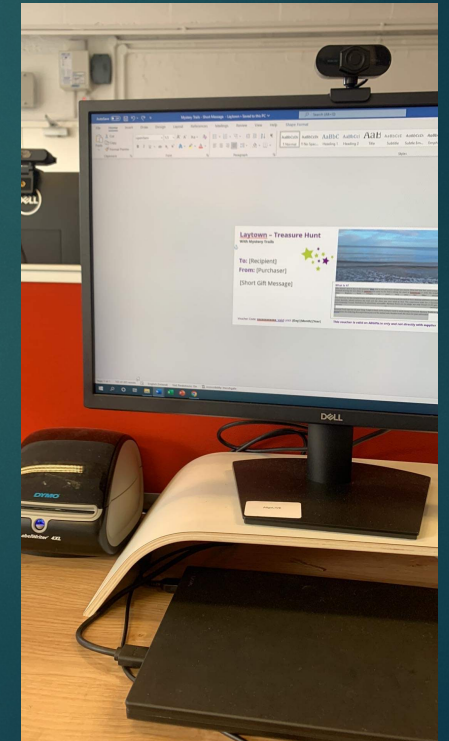
- ▶ Barbara and Alan Kearns, their kids and Oscar
